- Properties evaluated for this Client have ranged from a single office building located on less than one acre of former farm land to assemblages totaling 50 acres with a history of semi-conductor manufacturing and aerospace research.
- Due diligence services, including Phase II site investigations, are typically performed on accelerated transaction timeframes, often necessary in the aggressive San Francisco Bay Area real estate market.
- Being in Silicon Valley, this Client has acquired numerous properties on and near groundwater and soil vapor plumes of legacy chlorinated solvents, requiring intensive scrutiny. EKI also works closely with the client's Environmental Health & Safety team to evaluate potential risks to its contractors and employee occupants due to vapor intrusion, during and after acquisition.

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
